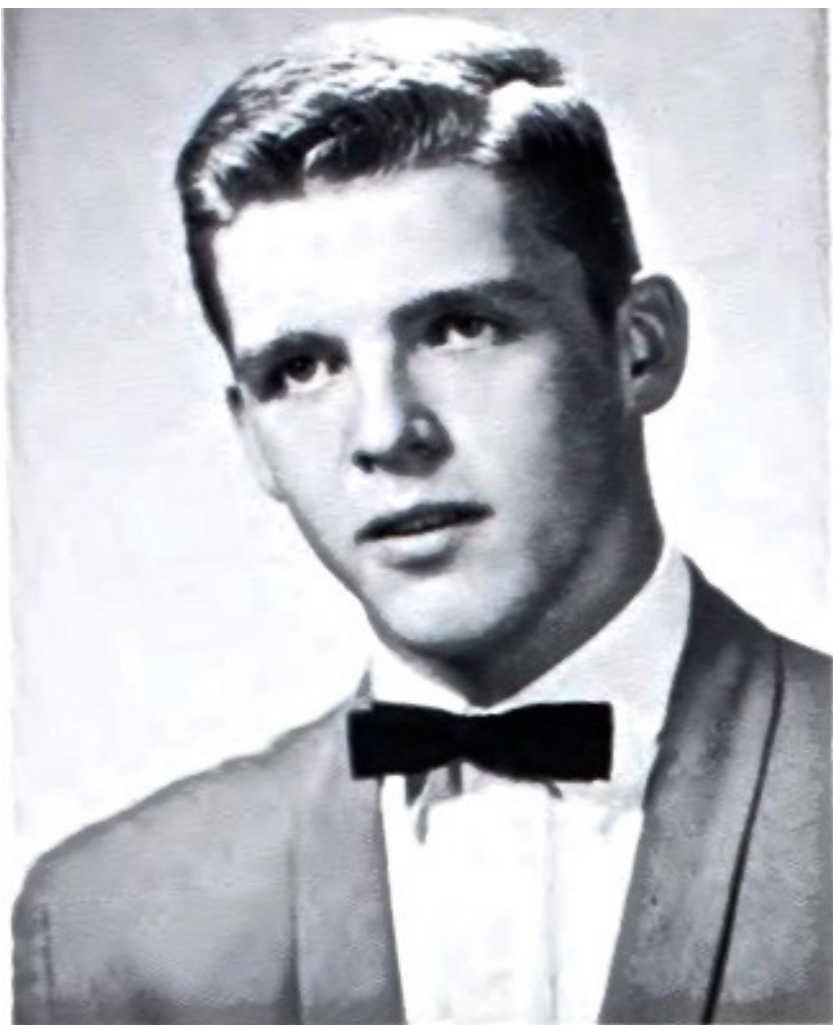




GETTING READY—St. Peter's Prep football coach Bill Cochrone explains what he wants done Sunday against Bayonne to four of his starters. From left to

PERSONNEL—The hard running of Tony Mendella and John Cross gives St. Peter's a potent running game while Jack O'Dea is a point quarterback who can throw the long touchdown pass almost anytime. In the line, Cochran depends on guard Bob Zalkar, ends Gene Torpey and Bill O'Day, and tackle Len Francis.

PERSONNEL—First year quarterback Fred Duma already has thrown two touchdown passes and has a favorite target in end Ted Zaborowski. Backs Nick Spadafino and Ray Kelly are hard runners with Kelly the workhorse on the Snyder team. Guard Ben Handhak, Max Jerskiell, Tony Matera and Lorenzo Danto are the stalwarts on the line.

PLAYERS TO WATCH—Spadafino, Duma, Zaborowski, Kelly and Handhak.

THE WRAP-UP—Snyder has held its two opponents to less than 70 yards rushing in two games. The Tigers have been inspired with a spirit that has been unknown at the Greenville school. St. Peter's has a potent running game in Mendella and Cross that should keep the Snyder forward wall busy. Snyder's pass defense hasn't been tested thoroughly and the likes of Jack O'Dea and ends Gene Torpey and Bill O'Day should make the difference in the game. Snyder winning streak should be broken.
