HIS WORK HISTORY WAS VAST; FIRST AS A PHYSICIST FOR RESYN CORP. IN LINDEN FROM 1963 – 1975, FOLLOWED BY TWELVE YEARS AS AN EMPLOYMENT SPECIALIST FOR THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF LABOR. HE CONTINUED AS AN ENVIRONMENTAL SPECIALIST FOR THE PINELLAS COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR TWELVE YEARS AND RETIRED IN 1999.

STEPHEN ALSO SERVED HIS COUNTRY IN THE U.S. ARMY, DURING THE VIET NAM WAR.

HE IS SURVIVED BY COUSINS AND OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS, NEIGHBORS AND MANY, MANY FRIENDS.
